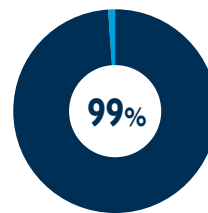

Your doctor believes you should be screened for familial amyloidotic polyneuropathy (FAP) or familial amyloidotic cardiomyopathy (FAC), an inherited genetic disease.

Alnylam offers you this screening through an independent laboratory free of charge. Early diagnosis can assist patients with FAP or FAC in getting the help and support they need.

How To Get Screened



1. Provide a blood sample

Screening for FAP or FAC takes a small amount of blood.



2. Get your results from your doctor

FAP or FAC screening results usually arrive in 2-3 weeks.

If your results are positive

When your results arrive, your doctor will tell you if you have a genetic mutation known to be associated with FAP or FAC. If you do, you are encouraged to discuss health care options with your doctor.
